Dr. Marjorie Neaderland, DVM, DACVO, will be testing our dogs' eyes. Dr. Dennis Trafny, DVM, DACVIM, will be providing Cardiac Auscultation and Echocardiograms. Dr. Judy Pawlusow, DVM, DACVIM(SAIM), will be testing our dogs' hearing (BAER test). Dr. Christine Scruggs, VMD, and her staff will be providing X-rays and other tests.

Please remember that this is a clinic, there will be no time for consultation with the Veterinarians.

We are offering:

- **Eye exams (ACVO CAER/CERF)** by Dr. Neaderland, DVM, DACVO.
- **Cardiac Auscultation and/or Echocardiogram** by Dr. Trafny, DVM, DACVIM. **NOTE:** The owner is NOT present in the room during the echocardiogram. If there is something abnormal or there are follow-up questions, a separate appointment with a veterinary cardiologist will be needed.
- **Hearing test (BAER)** Results are OFA and breed certifiable.
- **Anesthesia-free X-rays** of hips and elbows for OFA evaluation or preliminary screening. If your dog is unable to be restrained on the day, you will be given a refund of the cost. **Absolutely NO dogs over 80 lbs. for X-rays!** An image of your dog's X-rays will be provided to you by email by Dr. Chris. All X-rays will be submitted to OFA. You will not be informed of the results at the clinic. Forms for the X-rays MUST be filled out in advance; please be sure that you include a copy of your dog's AKC Registration with your Clinic registration form so that we can have paperwork ready for your signature when you arrive. You will need to fill in your credit card number in the appropriate place on the form for payment of the OFA fees before the test.
- **FLEX 4** blood test for heartworm and tick-borne diseases. You will be handed a Test Results Sheet for your dog before you leave so that you may take it to your veterinarian for consultation.

Other tests/services offered will be considerably discounted from your normal veterinary costs. They include:

- Senior Wellness Chemistry (recommended annually for any dog over 7 years old) that includes Superchemistry, CBC, T4, UA (remember to bring urine sample)
- Full Thyroid Panel (MSU - OFA registrable)
- Standalone T4
- Standalone CBC
- Brucella Test
- Patellar Luxation
- "Home Alone" Microchip

You will receive the blood test results (other than the FLEX 4 that you'll get before you leave) when available in an email from Dr. Chris.

Also offering, (at no charge for PWDs only), is a blood draw for the CHIC DNA Repository. The Repository collects and stores canine DNA samples along with corresponding genealogic and updated health information. Any qualified genetic researcher may apply to have access to these samples. You will need to download and fill out the form for the DNA repository and answer the health questions on the reverse side. The form can be reached from www.offa.org by clicking on "Application Forms" at the top of the main page and scrolling down to the DNA Repository Application.

If there are any other tests that you would like performed on your dog(s) other than the ones listed, please contact Mary (mary.mddk@gmail.com; 203-209-1346). She will get back to you promptly with availability and pricing.

Please read and complete the Registration Form carefully and please be sure to send a check for the correct amount.

Remember to send a copy of your dog's AKC Registration Certificate with your clinic registration form.
