Come join us to work on your water skills this winter. Entries are limited to 14 working teams each day (7 entries per club), unlimited auditor spots. This workshop is limited to 1 dog per household, per day.

Saturday: Junior-Working level teams must have basic obedience skills (sit, down, come, stay), and should be able to work around other dogs and people and must have a retrieve on command.

Sunday: Courier and Master working teams must have a Working level title.

Registrations will be accepted beginning January 16, 2025 and open only to club members until January 23rd. If the allocated spots are not filled by January 23rd, registration will open to non-Mayflower or Nutmeg members.

If all working spots are filled, you will have the option of either going on a wait list or auditing.

Dogs must be at least 6 months old. No bitches in season.

The Dry Dock workshop is open only to purebred Portuguese Water Dogs. The dogs must be in good health and proper fitness and condition for the seminar that they are registering for.

I/we agree that the Nutmeg and Mayflower Portuguese Water Dog Clubs, Inc. has the right to refuse this entry or any entry for any cause(s) which it deems sufficient.

I/we accept full responsibility for the care of my/our dog(s) before, during and after, the workshop.

I/we agree to hold the above-listed [clubs and organizations], [their] [its] members, directors, governors, officers, agents, judges, instructors, volunteer organizations, individual helpers, superintendents and/or show secretary(ies), the owner or lessor of the premises and/or any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of my/our dog(s) while in or upon the Exercise Finished premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto; and I/we personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claims.

I/we agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of my/our dog(s) by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog(s), whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I/we hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in this dry dock seminar, however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Notwithstanding any of the above, in the event that I/we or my/our dog(s) suffer any damage, injury, illness, or loss (including the death of my dog(s)), during the Dry Dock seminar or am in any way involved in any other party's claim of damage, injury, illness, or loss during the workshop I/we agree to arbitrate the claim according to the rules of the American Arbitration Association. I/we further agree to arbitrate any question of whether any such claim is subject to such arbitration. I/we agree that any such arbitration shall take place at an agreed upon site in the greater Stamford, Connecticut area within 45 days of the incident giving rise to the claim, or at such other place and time as the arbitrators shall agree.
